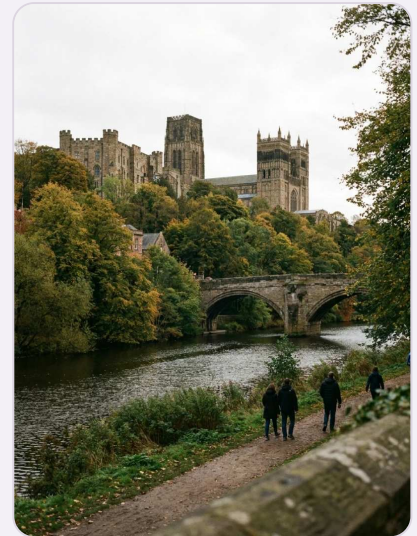


THE PROPOSITION · A SIMPLER WAY TO USE AI

THE IDEA

Set it up once. Use it every day.

STEP ONE

Put what you know in one place

Your team's answers, guidance and past work in one place the AI can search. No more hunting through inboxes and old drives.

STEP TWO

Let AI do the repeat jobs

Set up help for the tasks you do over and over, so the work no longer waits on the one person who knows how.

STEP THREE

Get more done at once

Run several jobs in parallel instead of one after another, with a person checking each one. More gets done, and the standard holds.

We are honest about what AI is for. It does the repeat work quickly, and people stay in charge of the parts that need judgement. We set this up with your own team and show it working on your real day to day, **before you commit to anything.**
